

## **Addendum to 05/03/10 APT Meeting**

**On May 24, 2010, Lynne Herndon, current APT Treasurer and APT President Elect, emailed the executive board recommending the following for a web vote.**

- 1. Increase the Educational Program budget to \$6000.00. Approximately \$3800 for the Kinder Roots Reading Program for Kindergarten, and \$3000 for the online AR Program. This is a \$1000 increase in the budget. \$500 had already been approved last year.**
- 2. Approve the online AR program at the \$3000.00 level. In the existing budget, there is only \$2200 remaining and the original estimate was around \$2500. This would be an increase of \$500 over what has already been approved.**

**Lynne explains,** "At the end of last school year, there were two votes by the APT Board concerning the online AR Reading Program. In the past, we had paid approximately \$2,000 a year for the paper tests. Going to the online program would be much more efficient and offer many more tests for what was estimated to be around \$500.00 more. In essence, there is a per-student charge and an annual renewal set-up fee. I failed to increase the Education program budget by the additional \$500.00 this year. We now have the bill for the 2010-2011 school year and it is \$2,950.00, or a little more than we approved last year. Therefore, I recommend the above be approved and made a permanent part of the budget."

**On May 24, 2010, a web vote took place to approve Lynne's recommendation.**

**Carla Monson made a motion, Rose Fritzke seconded, and all APT executive board members responded with the motion passing.**
