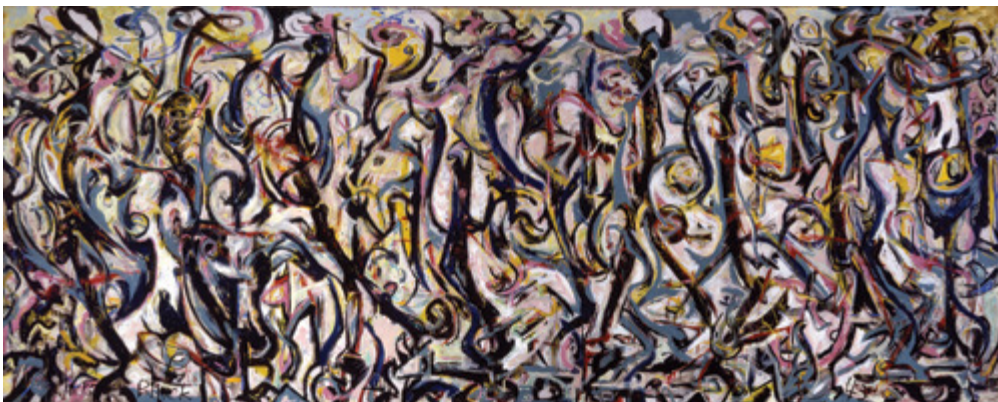

## Jackson Pollock Splatter Painting Directions

Materials:        Paper 9 x 12  
                      Newspaper to cover work area  
                      Tempera Paints  
                      Brushes, whisks, turkey baster, sponges  
                      Containers for water  
                      Large boxes to splatter paint in  
                      T-shirt smocks to protect clothes

Give a short summary of Jackson Pollock's life or read portions of the book to the class.

Show and discuss print "Mural"

This project is usually done outside. Set up newspaper and boxes that you will paint in. Put paper they will splatter paint on inside the box.

Cover the artist with an old t-shirt.

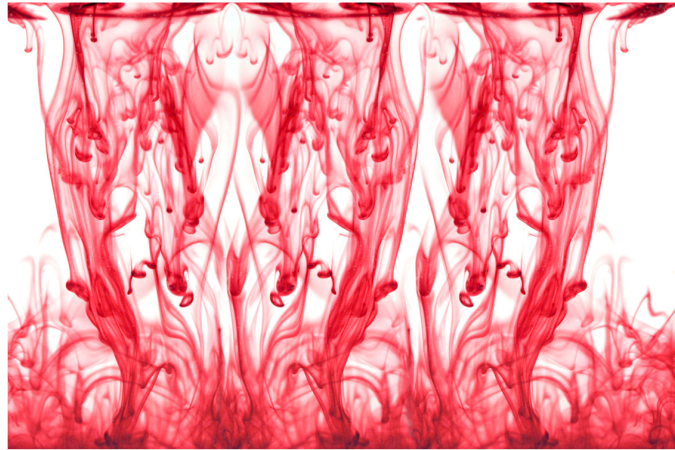
Begin by dipping a large brush (or whisk or sponge) into a container of tempera paint.

Hold the brush inside the box and splatter the paint onto the paper by shaking the brush from up to down in one large motion. Small motions are messier, but with some control also effective.

Add more colors and more splattering.
