### Preparation for project

- \*Chopsticks
- \*Cardboard work areas
- \*Colored tin

### Project directions:

Give introduction to cowboy boot, show project

Cut tin in advance, no larger than 8-1/2 x 11

Let kids cut out paper hat pattern and trace on tin, then cut out

Use cardboard under tin to make raised design

Be sure to work from the back of the tin, to have a raised design

Chopsticks are used as a tool to make designs. When sharpened similar to a pencil (but not as sharp) it makes a great tool

Have the kids practice on a scrap of leftover from cutting out hat

\*\*Mount on a 8 ½ x 11 paper, this will add stability to the tin

Embellish with cut ribbon, beads and "turquoise"
